9+1 TIPS & TRICKS FOR EFFICIENT RESEARCH

I. Use <u>GöDiscovery</u> to search across a wide range of content (about 50 million media items), from the local library holdings to various e-journals.

2. When researching on a certain topic, try different keywords that describe the topic (synonyms, related terms).

3. Use filters to refine your search results, e. g. select a time span or a publication type.

4. To explore databases suggested for your subject area, use **DBIS**.

5. Use wildcard operators, e. g. asterisk (*), question mark (?), to retrieve results that contain terms with various endings (econom* -> economics, *economical*, *economy*)

6. Use <u>EZB</u> to search for e-journals.

7. To search for a particular phrase, place it in quotation marks, e.g. "climate change".

8. Set up the university <u>VPN</u> to have access to licensed electronic materials when off campus.

9. Give Google a break and go for quality academic search tools (GöDiscovery, databases).
